- i Incorporated on 31 December 2001
- i Name change from ALLG to the ALLA in 2007
- i 700 + members
- i Aim to:

  - | provide forums for continuing education
  - | advocate on behalf of the interests of law libraries
  - | promote access to legal information within the wider community



# Library Workforce & Demographics

---

- i Approx 700 law library staff
  - | 91% female: 9% male
  - | 44% > 45 years or older
  - | 45% employed in profession > 16 years
- i Employed in
  - | law firms 42%
  - | government departments: 28%
  - | courts: 28%
  - | academic institutions: 10%
  - | other: 10%
